SUBJECT: Reminders – Trash Disposal and Recycling

The beautiful spring weather brings out the flowering trees and bushes; unfortunately, it also entices the birds and rodents who are foraging for food after the long, harsh, cold winter. You can do your part to impede the success of the animal life in feeding on discarded foodstuffs by following these guidelines:

To deter wildlife from “picking up” your trash:

- If possible, place your trash ***inside a trash can*** and ***secure the lid***.
- If you live in a unit that does not provide space for trash containers, place your trash in ***durable (thick) trash bags*** and fasten them securely.
- Trash should be placed curbside for pickup ***no earlier than 6 PM of the evening before the pickup date and no later than 6 AM the day of the scheduled pickup day***. Trash cans should be returned no later than 6 pm of the trash pickup day.

Trash / Recycling Pick-Up Schedule

(Both trash and recycling will be picked up on the scheduled days between 6 AM and Noon)

Mondays	Trash <i>and</i> Recycling Pick Up
Thursdays	Trash Pick Up <i>and</i> <u>One</u> Bulk Item/Unit

Recycling Instructions

- **Glass /Cans/Plastics** - Place rinsed-out glass (brown, green & clear), aluminum cans, bi-metal cans & #1-7 plastics (flattened) ***inside the recycling container***.
- **Newspapers, Junk Mail, Magazines, Cereal Boxes (inside packaging removed)** – ***Must*** be bundled & tied ***or*** put in a brown paper bag and placed ***alongside the recycling container***.
- **Cardboard** – Must be flattened and placed in the ***dumpsters*** for ***“Cardboard only”*** in the clubhouse parking lot.

****** Please note: the waste removal company will not take electronic equipment, ceramics, dishes or window glass, aerosol cans, wire hangers, tin foil or pots and pans.***
